Candlelight's 'The Full Monty' is plenty of fun

The Candlelight Theatre in Delaware recently kicked off its 2014 season with a hilarious production of "The Full Monty," wonderfully directed by Rob Harris. "The Full Monty," book by Terrence McNally and composed by David Yazbek, is an Americanized, musical version of the British film. The show is set in Buffalo and focuses on six unemployed steel workers who are frustrated by lack of work and feeling emasculated because the women have become the bread winners. Best friends Jerry Lukowski and Dave Bukatinsky are brainstorming employment opportunities when their attention is caught by a commotion at the local theatre. A touring Chippendale show is in the area and every lady in town is there, including Dave's wife, Georgie. Jerry and Dave sneak into the show to get Georgie out when Jerry has a sudden flash of inspiration. If the women will pay top dollar to see a bunch of strangers strip, how much would they be willing to pay for the real deal in the form of authentic Buffalo men? Especially if, unlike the Chippendales, the guys are willing to go "the full monty" and strip bare. Dave is hesitant but Jerry persists and the duo begins auditions to flesh out their act. An eclectic group forms and, as they work on their song and dance numbers, they also work through their insecurities.

Candlelight's all-star cast features C.J. Celeiro as Jerry, David T. Snyder as Dave, Bob Miller as Harold, Peter Briccotto as Malcolm, Billy D. Hart as Ethan and Michael Hogan as Horse. Alex Ryan is terrific as Jerry's son, Nathan. The main men are supported by Laura Boyer as Pam, Jerry's ex-wife, Catherine Logan as Georgie and Lindsay Mauck as Vicki. Susan Dewey is outstanding as Jeanette, a wise cracking former performer who comes out of retirement to help the men. Chris M. Balbi starts the show off right as stripper Keno Walsh.

"The Full Monty" is certainly not for everyone – there is nudity and strong language – but the show is a lot of fun. Both the physical and verbal comedy is incredibly funny. The cast, especially Snyder and Briccotto, are very expressive and comical. And although the content is geared toward adults, the themes are universal – self-consciousness, feeling inferior, wanting to rise above your situation, love for your spouse, parent or child, and many more. The actors work well together and compliment the differences in the characters. Hogan's Horse is the oldest of the group but the most grounded. Miller's Harold is more stoic than the rest but the moments when Harold loses his reserve are very humorous. Hart and Briccotto are the novices of the group, Snyder is the voice of reason and Celeiro is the driving force.

Mauck's Vicki appears flighty and materialistic, but when it comes down to brass tacks, she is supportive and understanding. Logan's Georgie is sympathetic and compassionate. Boyer's Pam appears more unyielding than the other characters but her toughness toward Jerry is out of love for their son

Everything about the show was well done – from Chris Miller's excellent lighting to Timothy Lamont Cannon's costumes (or sometimes lack of costumes) to Jeff Reim's set. Music was well chosen by
